


DISCOVER THE POWER OF STEAM

Technological innovation and digital literacy have clearly transformed education and the way in which we teach in the classroom.

As a Microsoft Showcase School, we are committed to ensuring that our pupils receive an education that embraces the use of technology to spark innovation, enhance pupil engagement and enable both collaboration and autonomy in their own learning.

Every pupil from Year 3 to 11 is provided with their own 1-2-1 device, whilst our pupils in Nursery to Year 2

use iPads within their classrooms.

Pupils can gain Microsoft accreditations as well as experience using digital platforms and learning tools such as One Note, Minecraft Education and Reading Coach.

We are proud to have been accredited as a Common Sense School for our commitment to encouraging our pupils to take ownership of their digital lives and for our culture of responsible digital citizenship.

Championed as part of the core education and supported through cocurricular activities and clubs, the Arts are at the heart of our STEAM education, inspiring creativity, critical thinking and problem-solving skills for tomorrow's world.

Every day, whether in their classrooms, technology workshop, art room, broadcasting, recording studio or in our purpose-built Performing Arts Wing, which houses our Drama Studio, Music Rooms and Dance Studio,



A FOCUS ON... SCIENCE



Our Climate Science Lab provides pupils with hands-on learning experiences that focus on addressing climate change through the integration of science, technology, and creativity. By exploring the science behind environmental challenges, pupils learn to apply critical thinking and innovative problem-solving skills to develop sustainable solutions.






The Food Science Lab at our STEAM Centre offers pupils a dynamic, hands-on learning environment where they can delve into the science behind food, from its chemistry and biology to its impact on health and the environment. Through engaging activities, pupils explore how food is produced, processed, and consumed, fostering creativity and critical thinking as they experiment with food safety, nutrition, and sustainable practices.



A FOCUS ON... TECHNOLOGY & ENGINEERING/ELECTRONICS



Our STEAM curriculum, specifically the Technology and Engineering/Electronics programme, focuses on handson, collaborative learning experiences in technology and engineering, including programming Bee Bots in Nursery, 3D design with SketchUp, computer programming, app development, and podcasting. Pupils also gain practical skills in applying scientific and mathematical principles to design, build, and operate drones and VEX robotics systems.

A FOCUS ON... ARTS & MATHEMATICS



Emphasising the importance of the Arts, we embrace STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) to foster creativity, innovation, and critical thinking. Our Recording Studio allows pupils to explore music production, including sound recording, mixing, and editing, as well as podcasting. The Green Screen Room offers hands-on experience with special effects and virtual backgrounds to enhance storytelling. In our Textiles Room, pupils engage in garment design, sewing, and textile art, developing practical skills in fashion and design.







In our STEAM curriculum, mathematics plays a crucial role in solving real-world problems, from data analysis and mathematical modelling to designing structures and technology. Pupils gain strong critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills, enabling them to approach challenges with logic and precision. Whether applied in science experiments, technology development, or engineering design, mathematics is essential for success in STEAM fields.
